Adventure & outdoor operator workshops - register now!

Adventure and outdoor operators, make sure you understand how the new adventure activities regulations will affect your business. Register now for an operator workshop near you!

TIA and Outdoors NZ are running operator workshops in 11 locations throughout New Zealand over the next few weeks, starting in Taupo on 28 November.

The workshop will build on the May/June workshop, with an update on the adventure activities regulations which came into force on 1 November.

- Do you need to be registered with the Department of Labour?
- How do you notify?
- Audits - what is happening and what should you do?
- Who should you contact and how can you keep informed?

You will also find out about the new adventure and outdoor safety guide (due to be launched at the start of December) and how this web-based tool can contribute to safety in your business.

We will be seeking input on other review work relating to incident reporting, and competencies and qualifications. There will also be discussion about the activity specific guidelines to be developed next year.

Come and network with other adventure and outdoor operators, and share your ideas for improving safety.
